A: No, physical contact is not allowed for this young of age an group.

Q: *Does the daycare have any obligation to signing up or talking about the program?*

A: The daycare does not sign up any children but they can take payments for the instructor to pick up. And yes, it would be nice for them just to tell people about the program.
